## Fishing Rules Reminders:

- All bass must be released – no exceptions.
- Guests may fish in the catfish lake, but, must release all catfish and bass.
- Guests must pay the \$2.00 fishing, fee per person, before starting to fish.

## **2010 Fishing Derby:**

The fishing derby for 2010 is open. It ends on October 31. It is open to all club members, their children, and persons in their immediate household, including males 17 years old and younger. Measure the length of your fish to the nearest 1/16" and put your name, date, and fish length on the blackboard if it is larger than the fish listed there. Carry a measuring device with you and return any bass to the water very quickly. **All bass must be released.**
